- The following ticket limits apply to each of the Reserves*:
 - AFL Reserve 10 tickets per transaction
 - MCC Reserve 10 tickets per transaction
 - Club Member pre-sale 10 tickets per transaction (eight tickets per transaction applicable to ANZAC Day only)
 - General public - 10 tickets per transaction (eight tickets per transaction applicable to Anzac Day only)
- Ticketek sell reserved seat and general admission tickets in advance for most matches (some exceptions may apply, e.g. Anzac Day)
- The Ticketek Box Office has a permanent position at Gate 3B which only opens on event days. The Ticketek Box Office opens half an hour prior to MCC gate opening time on match days.
- The venue capacity for the football season is approximately 100,000.

Transaction fees are charged per transaction regardless of ticket volume.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Where is accessible seating located?**
Accessible seating is positioned all over the ground with the exception of P and Q levels in the Shane Warne Stand. Accessible seating allocations can vary event to event and may change without notice dependant on demand.
- **Is there general admission accessible seating available or do I have to pre-purchase?**
For any event where general admission seating is available, venue management endeavour to ensure accessible seating is also available on a first in first served basis. For the 2023 season, M52 accessible seats are typically held for general admission however there are some exceptions.
- **I have a standing room ticket, how early do I need to arrive at the ground so I can see the match?**
It is in your best interest to arrive as early as possible to guarantee a position in the front.
- **How many other people will be in the standing room bay as me?**
Standing room bays vary in capacities and it is dependant on which bay you have a ticket for. All bays have been measured according to building codes and standards.
- **Can I bring a stool / walking stool on wheels / cushion / portable chair to sit on while I am in the standing room bay?**
No, you cannot bring these items.
- **My child is participating in Auskick, where do I sit and how can I get extra tickets?**
Seats for Auskick participants are usually allocated in M27. The AFL distributes these tickets so all enquiries should be directed to the AFL.
- **Can I walk from one stand to the other via the MCC / AFL Members' Reserve?**
No, public are not permitted to walk through either the AFL or MCC Members' Reserves.
- **Can I enter via any public gate with my reserved seat ticket?**
All reserved seat tickets have a gate specified for entry. Ponsford Stand tickets all enter via Gate 1 only, however a reserved seat ticket for any seats within the Olympic Stand or Shane Warne Stand will permit entry via gates 3, 4 or 5.
- **Why don't you have all the seats at the venue available for purchase from when tickets go on sale?**
This allows for clear messages to be advertised regarding what bays are available for walk-up and what bays have already sold which provides better structure for venue management.
- **When are you going to release the bays that I want to sit in?**
Seats will be released when required based on the expected ticket sales.
- **Will my seat be undercover?**
Seats are not classified at the MCG as being undercover. Just because there is a roof over head does not necessarily mean it will protect you from the inclement weather. As a guide however, please [click here](#) to see where the drip line for each level lies.
- **I have been issued complimentary tickets, can I use these to upgrade to a reserved seat?**
No, complimentary tickets are usually for general admission seating only. If you require a reserved seat, then you need to purchase one at full price through Ticketek.
- **What will my view of the ground be like with a restricted view ticket?**
It depends on where your ticket is however most restricted view tickets allow for a majority of the playing surface to be seen and a visionboard/television.
- **Can an AFL member pre-purchase a reserved seat into the Public area?**
Yes, however the AFL member will pay the Club member upgrade price.
- **Can I purchase a reserved seat at the MCG on match day?**
Yes, subject to availability.
- **If I have lost my ticket, can I get it reissued?**
As long as relevant identification can be provided to confirm the initial sale, Ticketek are able to reissue lost tickets either prior to match day by contacting Ticketek or on match day from the Ticketek box office at Gate 3.

- There are two types of family tickets; one that consists of two adults and two children and one that consists of two adults and one child. Both family ticket types cost the same. Patrons buying a family ticket do not need to be related.
- Tickets purchased in advance may be collected from the Ticketek Box Office located at Gate 3B on the day of the match. Patrons must present their account confirmation number or customer ID issued at the time of purchasing the tickets.
- Persons with a general admission football club membership card (with entry entitlements) may purchase a reserved seat and only pay the seat and fee component of the ticket.

Concession Policy – Public Reserve

The following concession policy applies to the sale of daily public ticketing during the Toyota AFL Premiership Season competition:

Persons aged 15 and over as at 1 January in the current year are classified as an adult, unless they hold valid Concession identification.

A person must have the appropriate form of concession to purchase a concession ticket. They must present the relevant concession documentation at point of purchase and upon entry to the ground. A second form of identification (eg drivers licence, Medicare card, credit card) may be requested when purchasing or utilising a concession ticket to verify the concession entitlement.

Patrons holding one of the following cards are eligible to purchase a ticket at the concession rate;

- Centrelink issued: Pensioner Concession Card (PCC)*
- Department of Veterans' Affairs card or Department of Veterans' Affairs issued Pensioner Concession Card*
- Full time secondary or tertiary student cards**
- Centrelink issued: Health Care Card (HCC)*

*Primary cardholder only (not dependents) are entitled to the concession price.

** Does not include International Student cards

The AFL is a National Affiliate of the Companion Card program and they agree to provide an admission ticket for the cardholder's companion at no charge. The Companion Card program is applicable at all AFL Venues.

Junior Policy – Public Reserve

The following junior policy applies to the sale of daily public ticketing during the Toyota AFL Premiership Season competition:

- Children aged 6-14 as at 1 January in the current year are eligible to purchase a junior ticket.
- Children aged 5 and under as at 1 January in the current year are entitled to enter the ground at no charge; however they must not occupy a seat.
- Persons aged 15 and over as at 1 January in the current year are classified as an adult, unless they hold valid Concession identification.

Additional Information

- The AFL Reserve will occupy M16½-M27, N15½-N28, P15½-P28 and Q15½-Q28.
- Reserved Seats and General Admission tickets are sold at Gate 6 on match day.
AFL members are entitled to purchase a nominated number of guest passes depending on the match. Please direct members to visit membership.afl.com.au for this information. Subject to availability, AFL guest passes will also be on sale from Gate 6 only on match days
- Tickets purchased in advance may be collected from Gate 6 from gate opening time on the day of the match.
- AFL Reserve dry (alcohol free) areas are usually located in M27 for pre-purchase and walk-up, subject to availability. This bay will remain as a dry bay regardless of whether it is a walk-up bay or sold as reserved seats.
- A fixture of matches accessible using the Entertainment Book offer is available on the AFL website, <http://www.afl.com.au/tickets/entertainmentbook>.
- Adelaide Oval members have reciprocal access to the AFL Reserve for all homes and away season matches, excluding Anzac Day. These members only have scan access into the AFL Reserve and cannot upgrade to a reserved seat. Guest passes can only be purchased on match day from the AFL enquiries office at Gate 7 (subject to availability).

Junior Policy – AFL Reserve (applicable to Guest Passes)

The Victorian Government's public event framework requires all children 12 months of age and over to be included in attendee numbers, therefore the following will apply for the 2023 Premiership Season for the AFL Reserve:

- Children aged 12 months and under do not require a ticket, however they must not occupy a seat.
- Children aged 1-6 are admitted free but require a valid ticket
- Juniors aged 7-16 years are entitled to purchase a Junior ticket

- Barcode numbers of all members securing tickets will need to be quoted/provided when purchasing tickets in person, on the phone and online.
- Full, Restricted, Honorary, Playing and Temporary members will be able to purchase a maximum of four visitor tickets to all home and away matches except Anzac Day, when the limit will be two per member. Provisional members' ability to purchase visitor tickets will be based on the category of each match.
 - For category 1 - Provisional members are not entitled to purchase visitor tickets.
 - For category 2 - Provisional members will be able to purchase up to two visitor tickets per member and access Levels 1 & 4.
 - For category 3 matches - Provisional members will be able to purchase up to four visitor tickets per member and access all levels.
- Full, Restricted, Honorary, Playing and Temporary members will be able to pre-purchase reserved seats to all home and away matches for themselves as well as their guests. The number of reserved seats a Full, Restricted, Honorary, Playing or Temporary member can purchase for their guests will mirror the number of visitor tickets available per Full, Restricted, Honorary, Playing or Temporary member. The location of reserved seats for Provisional members to purchase will be based on the category of each match.
 - For category 2 matches - Provisional members will be able to purchase a reserved seat for themselves on Level 4 only, or Levels 1 or 4 when the transaction includes the barcode of an accompanying Full, Restricted, Honorary, Playing or Temporary member.
 - For category 3 matches - Provisional members will be able to purchase reserved seats for themselves and their guests on Levels 1, 2 or 4.
- MCC visitor tickets admit guests through Gate 2, which will give access to unreserved seating on levels 1 and 4 of the MCC Members Reserve. Access to member-only unreserved seating areas on levels 2 and 3 for guests will only be permitted if the member has obtained an internal Long Room or Balcony pass for them. Guests with a reserved seat ticket on level 2 do not require a balcony pass. Conditions apply and further information can be obtained from membership services on (03) 9657 8888 or visit the MCC website at www.mcc.org.au.
- MCC members can collect pre-purchased visitor tickets and reserved seats from the ticket windows at Gate 2A, upon production of their account confirmation number and membership card. Please note that visitors are not able to purchase or collect pre-purchased visitor tickets and reserved seats on match days if the member is not present.
- Reserved seating for mobility-impaired patrons, including wheelchair spaces and their carers (with Companion Cards), will be available via Ticketek (1300 665 915 or agencies) or in person at the club.
 - A member with a Companion Card will be able to gain access for their companion free of charge at all matches.
 - A guest with a Companion Card must have a visitor ticket to enter the Reserve and their companion will then be able to gain entry free of charge.

- Reserved seats will also be free of charge for Companion Card holders accompanying members and guests who have purchased their own reserved seat.
- To sell companion card tickets without the service handling fee, use offer code CCARD.

Child Policy

- Children under the age of six (at the time of the event) are admitted free of charge. Children aged six to 14 years are classified a child. Persons aged 15 and over at the time of purchase are classified as an adult.
- Provided they are accompanied by an MCC member, children with a junior AFL club membership (i.e. squadron) have GA access into the MCC Members Reserve for matches in which they have access to the public areas of the ground. Squadron barcodes can also be used to purchase a reserved seat upgrade.

Reciprocal Clubs

- The MCC has a reciprocal arrangement with specified Domestic, Interstate and Overseas Clubs. Upon presentation of their membership card and photo identification, full members of these clubs can purchase tickets into the MCC reserve during the cricket and football seasons. Ticketing can be purchased either in advance by completing the application form located on the website, or on the match day from the membership services windows at Gate 2B. Conditions apply and further information can be obtained from membership services on (03) 9657 8888 or visit the MCC website at www.mcc.org.au.

State Parliamentarians

- Victorian state parliamentarians have access to the MCC Members Reserve (subject to dress regulations) upon presentation of their valid State Parliamentarian MCC membership card or by booking in advance through Ticketek by quoting the valid barcode on their card. They have no entitlements to purchase visitor tickets. Federal or non-Victorian state parliamentarians have no access entitlements into the Reserve.

Additional Information

- Centre Wing membership is a Marvel Stadium-based membership granting reciprocal access arrangements for entry to the MCC Members Reserve.
- Current financial Centre Wing members are entitled to purchase one ticket per membership barcode to enter the MCC Members Reserve.
- Centre Wing members can purchase tickets for all AFL home and away matches (no access rights for finals).
 - Note: The total number of tickets available to Centre Wing members may be limited for some of the “blockbuster” matches such as Anzac Day and Queen’s Birthday.
- Centre Wing members are to enter through Gate 2, which will give them access to unreserved seating on levels 1 and 4 of the MCC Members Reserve. They are not permitted to member-only seating areas on levels 2 and 3.
- Centre Wing members will be able to utilise most of the bar, café and dining facilities in the Members Reserve with the exception of the Long Room and Members Dining Room.

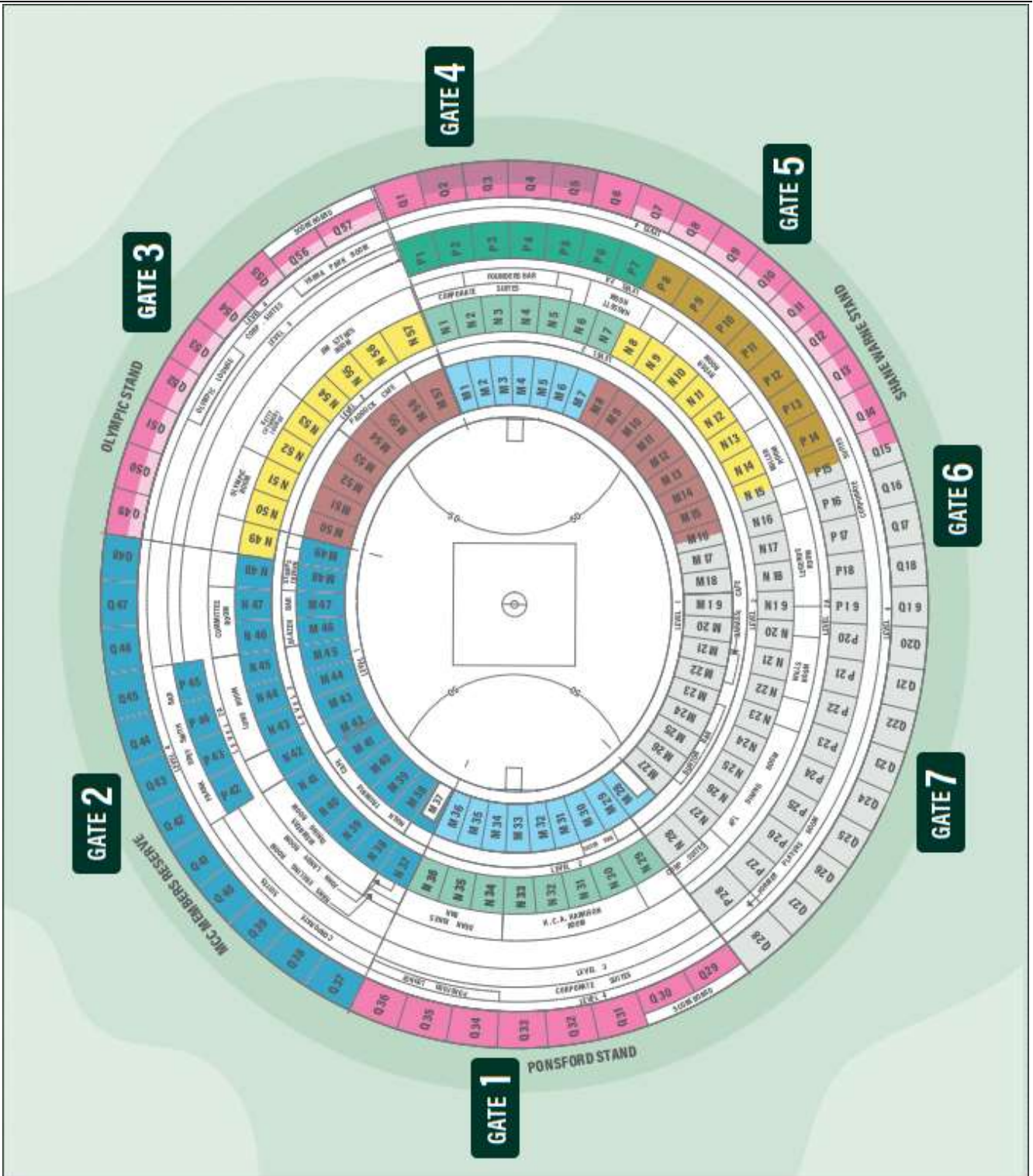

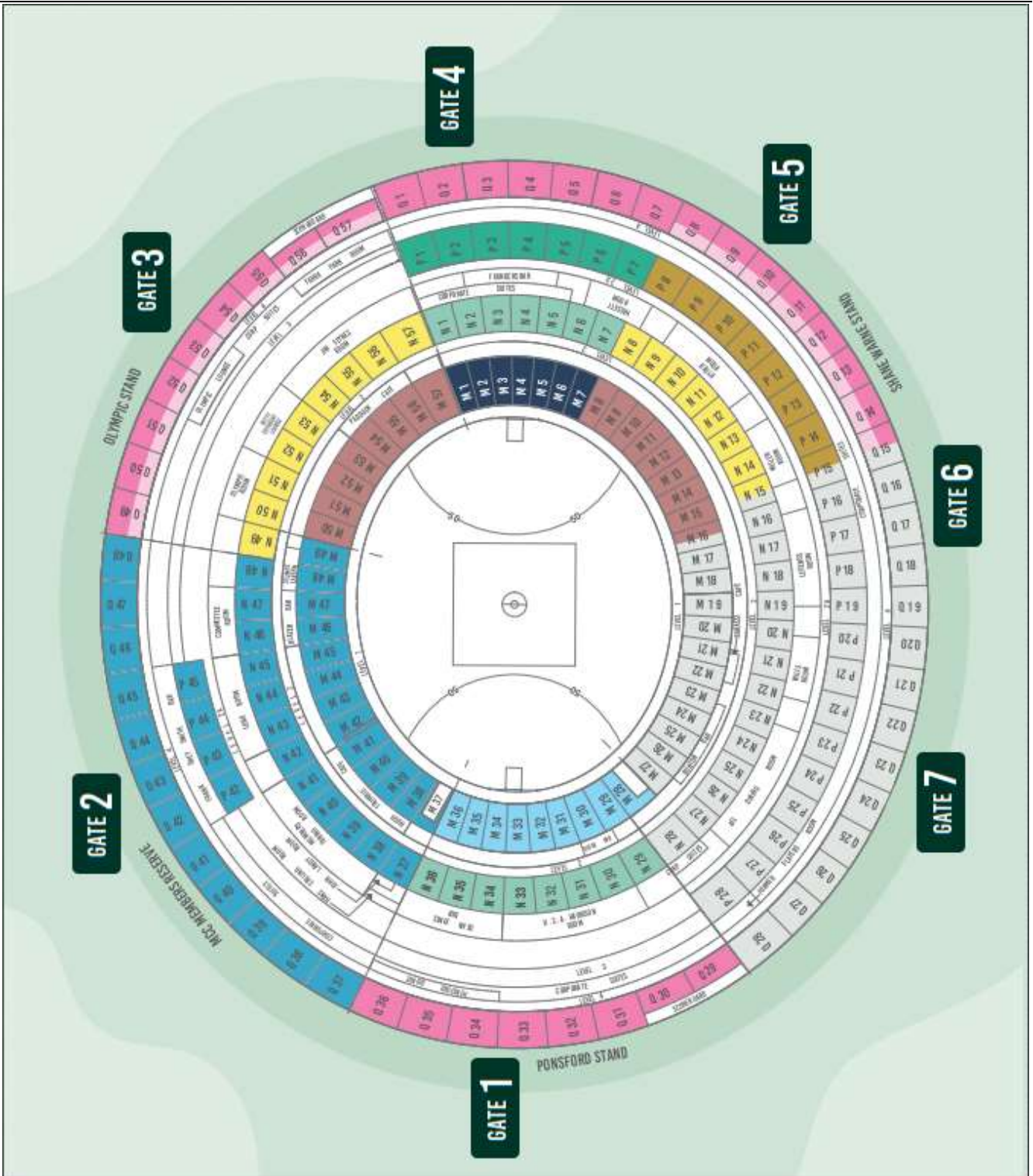

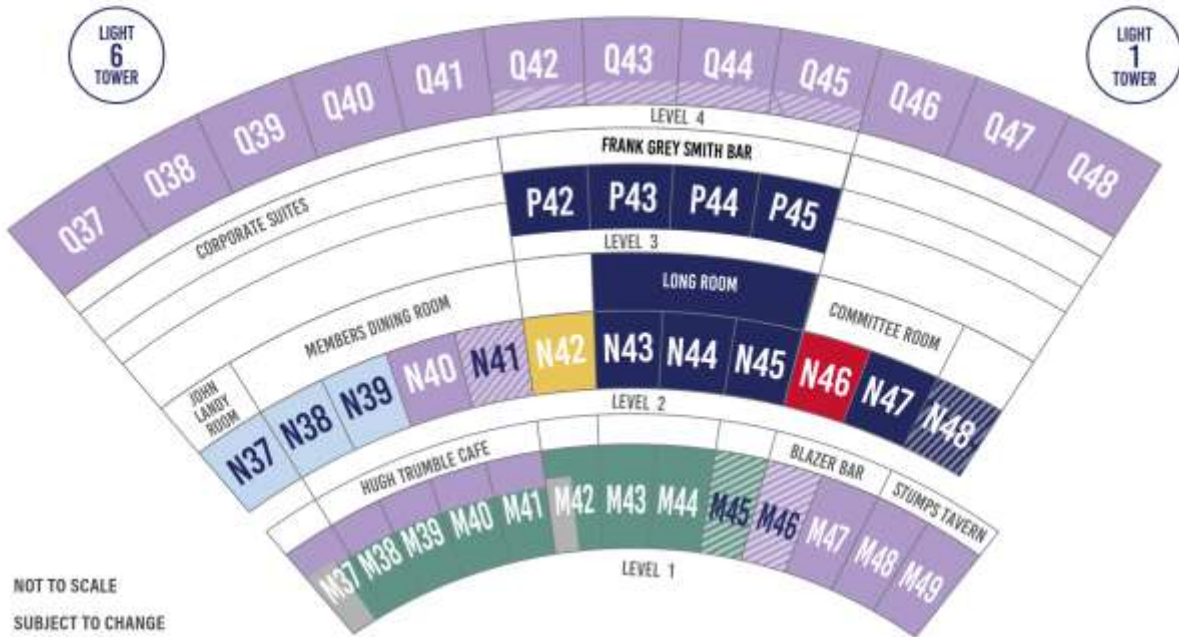
