

Conditions of Entry: Admission to Events: COVID-19

Personal:

- 1. By attending the MCG, you acknowledge that you have considered the health risks associated with your own personal circumstances, including any health condition or vulnerability that you may have, and the circumstances of persons with whom patrons will be in close contact following attending at the MCG.
- 2. You acknowledge that, some groups of people, such as people 70 years and older, people 65 years and older with one or more chronic medical conditions, people with compromised immune systems and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people 50 years and older with one or more chronic medical conditions, are especially at risk of serious infection from COVID-19. By attending an event you (and any persons who attend the event with you) acknowledge and accept these obvious risks
- 3. You must not enter the venue if your attendance is contrary to any COVID-19 issued health direction or any other law
- 4. You are required to register your attendance at the venue for contract tracing purposes by scanning a QR code on arrival at gate entry or selecting the 'dynamic check-in' on your electronic tickets, this well then be checked by a staff member, or by providing your hard copy details to the MCC.
- 5. You must be fully vaccinated to attend the event or provide a valid medical exemption for not being vaccinated. In both cases you must produce a COVID-19 digital certificate (which either confirms your full vaccination status or a valid medical exemption) to our staff at the entry point. You can no longer use a medical certificate as evidence of COVID-19 vaccination exemption.
 - a. Children under the age of 12 and two months are exempt from Condition 5.
- 6. If you appear unwell and exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19, you will be refused entry or requested to leave the venue.
- 7. You must adhere to the following COVID Safe requirements:
 - a. Stay home if you are feeling unwell, currently have symptoms of COVID-19, have been instructed by the Department of Health to isolate, or have recently been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case and undertaken a COVID-19 test with results pending.
 - b. Practice physical distancing
 - c. Wear a face mask in accordance with health authority and venue requirements.
 - d. Follow signage and sit in the designated seating area on your ticket.
 - e. Wash your hands or use a hand sanitiser regularly. You can bring your own, or you can use one of our hand sanitizing stations in the venue.
 - f. Cough or sneeze into your elbow and dispose of tissues responsibly
- 8. Adhere to all requests of MCC Staff and MCC Contractors related to directions to minimise the risk of transmission of COVID-19.

Failure to adhere to the above requirements may result in you being requested to leave the venue.

Venue:

 The venue is operating as a 'cashless' venue during current COVID-19 restrictions. Please be advised that cash is not accepted throughout the MCG and precinct, this includes food and beverage and merchandise outlets.

2.	You must not approach any player, performer or match official, and must stay at least 1 seating rows (1.5 metres) away from the arena, interchange bench, player dug out or player / official arena-race at all times.
