TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entry into this Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. The promoter is the Melbourne Cricket Club, ABN 92 871 871 964 of the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG), Yarra Park, Jolimont VIC 3002.

ENTRY AND PRIZE

- (A) To enter, upload a photo of your child's coloured-in sheet to Facebook or Instagram on 29 September 2019, tagged with **#MCGOPENDAY**.
- (B) The MCC will review the valid entries and determine a winner during the week beginning 30 September 2019, based on the best coloured-in sheet in the opinion of the MCC.
- (C) The winner will be notified via the social media profile used to enter the Competition, and will be awarded a family voucher to attend the National Sports Museum at the MCG (**NSM**), valid from the reopening of the NSM scheduled for February 2020 (the **Prize**). The family voucher comprises 2x adult tickets and 2x child tickets.
- (D) Subject to communicating their written acceptance of the Prize to the MCC, the winner will be announced publicly via the MCC's social media profile(s).

ELIGIBILITY

- (A) Entry into the Competition is open to Australian residents who attend the MCG Open Day on 29 September 2019. Directors, officers, management and employees (and their immediate families) of the MCC are ineligible.
- (B) If you are under 18 years of age, you must have your parent or guardian's consent to enter this Competition. The MCC reserves the right to request proof of age, identity, residency, and any required consent as above, prior to awarding the Prize.
